

- Avoid prolonged sun exposure to prevent color fading.

WARRANTY

LIMITED LIFETIME WARRANTY

1. NORSK Multi-Purpose Mat products are warranted to the original purchaser to be free from defects in material and workmanship for a period of two years from the date of the original retail purchase. The word "defect" is defined as imperfections that impair the use of the product. Defects resulting from misuse, abuse or negligence will void this warranty. This warranty does not cover defects due to alteration or accident. This warranty does not cover damage caused by vandalism or "acts of nature" or any other event beyond the control of the manufacturer.

WARRANTY

WARRANTY EXCLUSIONS

- a) Any/all labor costs for installation of original or replacement materials.
- b) Color variegations due to production run differences or exact color, shade, or mottling.
- c) Any/all damage resulting from improper installation or failure to follow recommended installation instructions.
- d) Any/all damage caused from improper use of chemicals and/or cleaning agents.
- e) Any/all damage caused by moisture, hydro static pressure, or alkali from the sub floor.
- f) Damage resulting from shoes such as golf spikes, high heels, or spiked shoes. Scratching, scuffing, tearing, cosmetic damage, or other wear and tear resulting from normal use of the product. In addition, any damage resulting from intentional damage, negligence, or unreasonable use will void this warranty.
- g) This product is not recommended for use in where food preparation takes place such as commercial kitchens. This flooring is not compatible with cooking oils and liquids from vegetable fats - These materials are not compatible with this flooring and can cause injury from slipping and unwanted microbial growth by impregnating the floor surface.
- h) Any/all damage resulting from the use of incompatible chemicals such as methyl ethyl ketone (MEK) or Acetone. Adequate testing of all chemicals potentially exposed to the flooring should be conducted prior to installation.
- i) NORSK Multi-Purpose Flooring is NOT intended for permanent outdoor installations – particularly in environments where there is extended exposure to weather and potentially slippery areas where the mats can slide. It is also NOT intended for permanent or extended use in outdoor playgrounds or pool areas.
- j) Any/all damage resulting from any pets. These may include but not limited to: chewing, scratching, urination or fecal matter.

TRIANGLE MAT CONFIGURATIONS








1a IDENTIFY PIECES

Keeping the triangles connected as a square tile, remove the borders and rotate the tiles so the mushroom shaped tooth is at the upper right corner. The up-diagonal (A) tile will have a split mushroom tooth and the down-diagonal (B) tile will have a solid mushroom tooth. Layout the tiles exactly as shown here and **make sure the smaller triangle is on the top and bigger triangle on the bottom of each square tile.**

1b To tell the difference between big and small triangles. You can align the 2 triangles at the 90° corner. The smaller triangle has 12 teeth along the diagonal and bigger triangle has 13 teeth.


2 ASSEMBLING PATTERN

Pick a pattern (1-15) from page 8-22 and layout each color as shown in Step 1. Start assembling according to colors and orientation of the triangles shown on diagram. Make sure the mushroom shaped tooth is at the upper right corner. **NOTE:** If the triangle doesn't fit, rotate triangle and cycle through the same color triangles until you find the one that fits correctly. (Refer to Step 1 & 3)




If you are having problems at any time, refer back to Step 1 & 3 to double-check the rotation of the triangles.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS



3 TEETH ALIGNMENT

Pay extra attention to the circled area of the patterns. Teeth should be level as indicated by the red dotted line. If not level, you connected the wrong piece. Rotate tile or use different tile of the same color.



4 ATTACHING BORDERS

Finish the mat with matching color borders (if there are enough pieces of that color) or use random colors.


